

Schwartz Mazda \$1,000,000 Bracket Challenge

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. PURCHASE DOES NOT IMPROVE CHANCES OF WINNING. THE FOLLOWING CONTEST IS VALID IN THE U.S. ONLY, AND IS OPEN ONLY TO QUALIFIED PERSONS (AS DEFINED IN THE RULES BELOW). VOID ELSEWHERE AND WHEREVER PROHIBITED. DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST IF YOU DO NOT FALL WITHIN THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AS SET FORTH BELOW.

Contest Name: Schwartz Mazda – \$1,000,000 Bracket Challenge (the “Contest”).

Contest Dates: Contest registration is scheduled to begin on **3/9/2010** and is scheduled to **end at 11:00am ET on 3/18/2010** (the “Registration Period”). The Grand Prize Contest is scheduled to occur between 3/18/2010 – 4/5/2010 during the designated 2010 Men’s College Basketball Tournament. Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations and is void outside the U.S. and where prohibited.

- **Designated Tournament:** 2010 Men’s College Basketball Tournament being played between 3/18/2010 – 4/5/2010, with the Semi-Final & Championship games to be held in Indianapolis, IN.

Who May Enter: Contest is open to legal residents of New Jersey, who are **age 18 or older** as of date of entry, and have a valid U.S. driver’s license except the following persons who are not eligible to enter or win:

- (a) Employees, officers, and directors of **Schwartz Mazda** (“Sponsor”), **Millennium Radio Group, participating Millennium radio stations (WJLK-FM, WCHR-FM, WOBB-FM, WADB-AM), other participating Sponsors, Million Dollar Media, LLC** (the “Administrator”), other participating Sponsors, each of their respective franchisees, parents, affiliated companies, subsidiaries, distributors, retailers, printers, advertising and promotion agencies, and any and all other companies associated with the design or execution of this promotion (collectively, “Released Parties”), and the members of the immediate families or households, whether or not related, of any of the above. “Immediate family members” includes, for purposes of this promotion, parents (including in-laws), grandparents, siblings (including step-siblings), children (including step-children), grand children (including step grand children) and each of their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside.
- (b) Individuals who do not have access to an internet connection in order to visit the contest website, or a valid email address to register.

How to Enter – On-Line Registration: Visit **any participating Millennium Radio station home page** during the “Registration Period” to connect to the Contest registration page. Fully complete the on-line registration with all required information, including your name, complete address (*including city, state and zip*), valid email address, birth date, and phone number (*including area code*). Each registrant will designate their own ‘Screen Name’, and must enter their username (email address) and password. The designated ‘Screen Name’ will be displayed on the ‘Standings Page’ during the contest. Each registrant’s username (email address) & password will allow participants to return to the contest site to Log-in and view their prediction, points and standings.

After having read and agreed to these Official Rules, click the submit button to submit your on-line registration. All entries must be fully complete for all required registration information. Any entry submitted with an invalid email address will be disqualified. **Maximum of one entry per person or per valid email address.** Any contestant submitting more than one entry will void all entries by that contestant. Any available opt-in opportunities are not required to enter the Contest, and checking the opt-in boxes will not improve your chances of winning.

Bracket Prediction – Must be completed and submitted by 11:00am ET on 3/18/2010:

Bracket predictions must be completed and submitted between:

- **3/14/2010 – Following team selection announcements for the designated Men’s College Basketball Tournament**
- **3/18/2010 – Prior to 11:00am ET**

Bracket: Once the designated 2010 Men’s College Basketball Tournament team selections have been announced on 3/14/10 – all registered or newly registering participants must fully complete the provided Bracket Prediction form on the Edit/Update Picks page of the contest website.

Tie-Breaker: Each participant will also be required to submit their prediction of the **Total Cumulative Points** to be scored in the Championship Game on 4/5/10. Any contestant who failed to complete the Total Cumulative Points ‘tie-break’ prediction will be assigned a point total of 0 cumulative points for the Championship Game.

Save Picks: Participants are required to click the ‘**Save Picks**’ button on the contest website to save their bracket predictions selections, cumulative score prediction or updates to their predictions. Any changes or predictions made without clicking the ‘Save Picks’ will not be saved or recognized for this contest.

Completed bracket prediction entries must be **received by 11:00am ET on 3/18/2010** in order to be eligible to participate or claim any prize. Any registered participant or contestant who fails to fully or correctly complete the on-line registration form, or fully and correctly complete the required Bracket Prediction for all (63) games in the designated tournament (and Save their picks) will be disqualified from the contest and will be ineligible to claim any prize (*see below*). Any bracket prediction not received by the required deadline for any reason including, but not limited to transmission error, internet problems, equipment or website malfunction, internet traffic or errors caused by viruses or hackers will be disqualified. Sponsor is not responsible for any delays or difficulty in receipt an eligible contestant’s Bracket Prediction that prevents participation.

Any incomplete or illegible entries will be disqualified. Released Parties are not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, illegible, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, damaged, or for entries submitted in a manner that is not expressly allowed under these rules, or for any entry not submitted or received due to any technical error or failure, unauthorized human intervention, inaccurate capture or mis-entry of any required information, or the failure to capture any such information or effects of hackers or failure of any electronic equipment, computer or cellular transmissions and/or network connections; all of which will be disqualified.

Each participant must submit an entry on his/her own behalf. Any entry submitted on behalf of another individual or using another person's email address or name will be disqualified and ineligible to claim any prize. No mechanically reproduced or automated entries permitted. Use of any automated system to participate is prohibited and will result in disqualification and all such entries will be deemed void.

In the event of a dispute as to any on-line registration, the authorized account holder of the e-mail address used to register will be deemed to be the registrant and he/she must be eligible according to these Official Rules. The "authorized email account holder" is the natural person assigned an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted address. All entries received become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned.

Scoring – Bracket Points: Each eligible participant who has successfully completed the on-line registration and bracket prediction as required by these Official Rules will receive 1-point for each of the (63) games for which they have correctly predicted the winning team. Any incorrect predictions will receive 0 points. The maximum point total for correctly predicting the winning team in every game played during the designated Men's College Basketball Tournament is 63 points. At the completion of the designated tournament, each eligible contestant bracket prediction received will be compared to the actual bracket outcome.

Tie Breaking Procedures – Bracket Winner: In the event of a tie among any point leaders in the Bracket prediction, the tie-breakers to determine the 'Bracket Winner' for the 1st place prize package and bonus prize package (if there is any bonus prize winner(s)) shall be as follows:

- Contestant who has predicted closest to the actual Cumulative Points total in the Championship game, regardless if the prediction is higher or lower than the actual point total.
- In the event of a remaining tie among any eligible contestants, the tie-breaker shall then be a random drawing conducted by the Contest Administrator.

In order for the grand prize to be awarded, an eligible contestant must correctly predict all (63) games in the designated Men's College Basketball Tournament, thereby scoring a perfect 63 points. **If no eligible contestant correctly predicts all 63 games, then the Grand Prize will not be awarded.**

In order for the bonus prize to be awarded, an eligible contestant must correctly predict (60) or more games in the designated Men's College Basketball Tournament, thereby scoring 60 or more points. If no eligible contestant correctly predicts 60 or more games, then the **Bonus Prize will not be awarded.**

Prize Awards: The following prize awards will be available to eligible contestants participating in the Contest:

Grand Prize – Predict all (63) Games Correctly ("Perfect Bracket"): If an eligible contestant correctly predicts all (63) games in the designated Men's College Basketball Tournament, they will be eligible to claim the grand prize subject to verification of compliance with these official rules. The grand prize is: **\$1,000,000 40-year annuity. If awarded, grand prize will be payable in (40) equal annual installments of \$25,000 Cash, without interest, on or about the anniversary date of the winning attempt.** The first installment will be awarded approximately 2 to 4 weeks following verification and approval of all required contest information.

A maximum of one (1) grand prize will be awarded. In the event of multiple winning entries, then the cash value of the grand prize will be evenly distributed among eligible winning contestants. **If no eligible contestant successfully completes the grand prize winning requirements, then the grand prize will not be awarded.**

Bonus Prize – Predict (60) or more Games Correctly: If an eligible contestant correctly predicts (60) or more games in the designated Men's College Basketball Tournament, they will be eligible to claim the bonus prize subject to verification of compliance with these official rules. The bonus prize is: **a new Mazda vehicle from Schwartz Mazda with a maximum retail value not to exceed \$25,000.**

Winner must accept delivery of vehicle from the sponsor designated dealer, or as otherwise specified by Sponsor. Administrator will solely designate and specify available vehicle including make, model, color and options for Grand Prize winner's prize award. Grand Prize winner may not substitute, exchange, or apply the vehicle's value towards a higher cost or alternate vehicle. Designated vehicle must be the Sponsor designated vehicle that is currently in designated dealer's stock of inventory. Administrator reserves the right to award an alternate year model (*i.e.* 2009), if the 2010 model is not available at the time of prize award.

If the designated prize vehicle MSRP is under \$25,000.00, the winner will not be awarded the difference between the vehicle's actual MSRP and \$25,000.00. Grand Prize winner is responsible for paying any and all sales tax on prize award at time of delivery, estimated at approximately \$1,500 (based on a 6.0% tax value) but may vary depending on the state and county in which the vehicle is awarded.

All other costs and expenses related to prize acceptance and use not specified herein as being provided are the sole responsibility of Grand Prize winner, including but not limited to tax, title, insurance, license and registration fees. All income, federal, state and local taxes are Grand Prize winner's sole responsibility. Administrator reserves the right to substitute a prize of comparable or greater value, at its sole discretion.

A maximum of one (1) bonus prize will be awarded. In the event of multiple winning attempts, then the tie-breaking procedures outlined above will be used to determine the 'bonus prize' winner. If no eligible contestant successfully completes the bonus prize winning requirements, **then the bonus prize will not be awarded.**

1st Place Prize – Most Correct Games ("Bracket Winner"): The eligible contestant who predicts the most games correctly (*excluding any grand prize or bonus prize winner(s)*), thereby earning the most points in the bracket challenge, will be eligible to claim the 1st Place Prize subject to verification of compliance with these official rules. The 1st Place prize is: **a station prize package with a maximum retail value not to exceed \$250.** Exact prize package will be as solely specified and announced by participating stations. Winner must accept delivery of prize as specified by Sponsor.

A maximum of one (1) 1st Place prize will be awarded. In the event of multiple contestants being tied for the most games predicted correctly, then the tie breaking procedures (*see above*) will apply for determining the 1st Place winner.

All prize awards are non-cumulative. Maximum of one prize award per participating contestant. All applicable federal, state and local taxes are the winner's sole responsibility. All prize awards are non-transferable and no cash redemption or prize substitution allowed, except at Sponsor's sole discretion or as provided herein. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize of comparable or greater value, at its sole discretion. Maximum retail value of all available prizes: **\$1,025,250.**

All of the following will apply for each prize winner: 1) Winner will be required to complete and return, within 5 days of date of receipt, a W-9 form (if prize value exceeds \$600), an affidavit of eligibility, and a liability/publicity release (where permitted); 2) Winner will be required to present a copy of a valid social security card and a valid driver's license as a condition of participating or receiving any prize; 3) Winner will be issued an IRS Form 1099 reflecting the actual value of all prizes won, if prize value exceeds \$600; and 4) Winner will be responsible for paying all applicable taxes (including, but not limited to all local, state and federal taxes) on all prizes awarded. Released Parties are not responsible for mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software errors, malfunctions or failures of any kind, including: failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmission of online entries, traffic congestion on telephone lines, the Internet or at any website or lost or unavailable network connections which may limit an online entrant's ability to participate in the Contest, and any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer or mobile phone related to or resulting from participating in or downloading any information necessary to participate in the Contest.
